# LearntobeHealthy.org® Progress Continues

In January 2008, the Byrnes Health Education Center was awarded two consecutive years of funding through Highmark Healthy High 5, a children's health promotion initiative of the Highmark Foundation. As we continue through the third year of our relationship with the Highmark Healthy High 5 initiative, the Byrnes Health Education Center continues to steadily expand our reach and add new materials to the site. Below you'll find the three primary objectives of the grant and a brief description of progress towards our goals.

## Objective #1: Expand the reach of LearntobeHealthy.org Website

Among the many features and products added to the LearntobeHealthy.org site during 2008/2009 were multiple kits (suites of activities) relating to mental health. The activities are designed to promote self-esteem, healthy decision making, respect and other traits that help to prevent bullying. Kits include:

- *"Sealing" Me for Me*: an underwater themed kit for grades K-3
- *The Power of Me*: a carnival adventure for grades 4-6
- *Life on Demand*: helping students maintain good mental health in grades 7-9
- *Face the Music*: exploring healthy decisions and outlooks in grades 10-12

## Objective #2: "Complete the Circle" with Community Programs

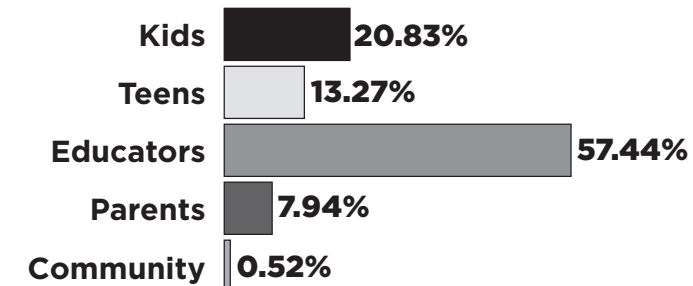

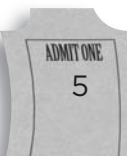
## Objective #3: Ensure the Sustainability of LearntobeHealthy.org

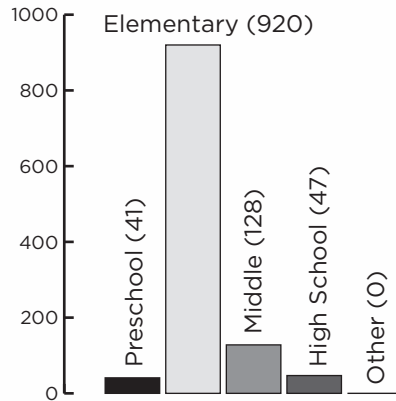

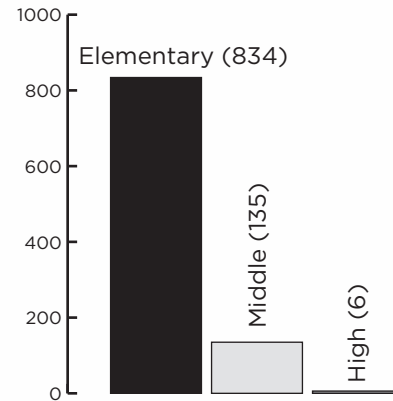

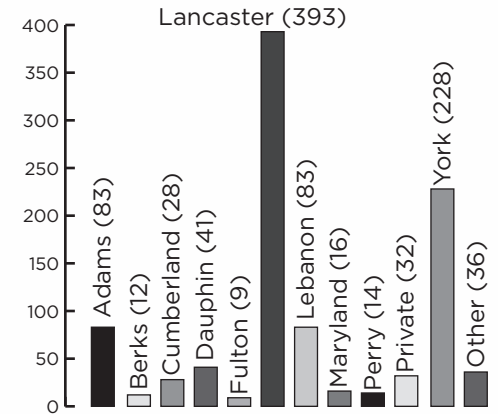

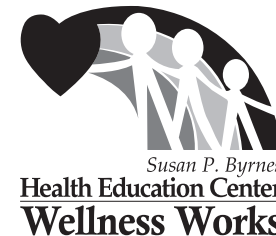
# The Byrnes Health Education Center Healthy Company of the Year - Harley-Davidson Motor Company

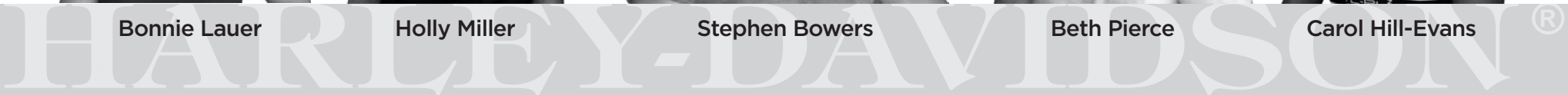

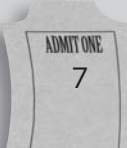
